ADMISSIONS REVIEW AND INTERVIEW

The admissions team reviews all application materials. Qualified candidates will progress to a virtual interview.

3

ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE MAKES DECISION

The admissions committee decides whether a candidate will be offered admittance to the program.

4

CANDIDATE DECISION

The candidate is informed of admittance to the program and must decide whether to accept the offer.

5

DEPOSIT AND POST-ACCEPTANCE DOCUMENTS

The candidate submits a deposit and sends all required post-acceptance materials.

6

START MEDICAL SCHOOL

The medical journey begins at AUC School of Medicine's Sint Maarten campus or the Preston, United Kingdom, location.

PROGRAM ENTRY AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Our MD program is open to qualified candidates who have at least a bachelor's degree or equivalent, in any subject from an accredited university. Science-focused study is preferable but optional.

MEDICAL SCHOOL PREREQUISITES

Two semesters (8 credit hours) including labs for each of the following:

- General Biology
- General Chemistry
- Organic Chemistry or Biochemistry

One semester of:

- General Physics, Calculus, or Statistics

Substitutions and/or exceptions for med school prerequisites are made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the admissions committee.

MEDICAL ADMISSIONS TEST

- U.S. Citizens/Permanent Residents of the U.S.: MCAT
- Non-U.S. Citizens/Permanent Residents: MCAT, UCAT, NEET, or GAMSAT

Please note that AUC School of Medicine will not consider MCAT, UCAT, and NEET scores more than five years old. For the GAMSAT, only scores less than two years old will be considered.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Personal Statement/statement of purpose: a maximum of 750 words.
- Letters of Recommendation/reference: a minimum of one academic letter and one professional letter. Two academic letters can be submitted if a professional letter cannot be obtained.

Educational/Employment History

CV or resume: A chronological history of your educational, employment, and volunteer experience.

Transcripts

For the initial review, unofficial transcripts are acceptable; however, before matriculation, AUC must receive final, official transcripts (showing conferred degree if applicable) directly from the university to ensure authenticity.

AUC INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Citizens and permanent residents of countries other than the U.S., Canada, Australia, or New Zealand may qualify for an AUC School of Medicine Scholarship of up to \$80,000 USD.

Applicants must be admitted to AUC School of Medicine for the scholarship to be awarded. AUC School of Medicine Scholarship Committee reviews and awards scholarships every week.



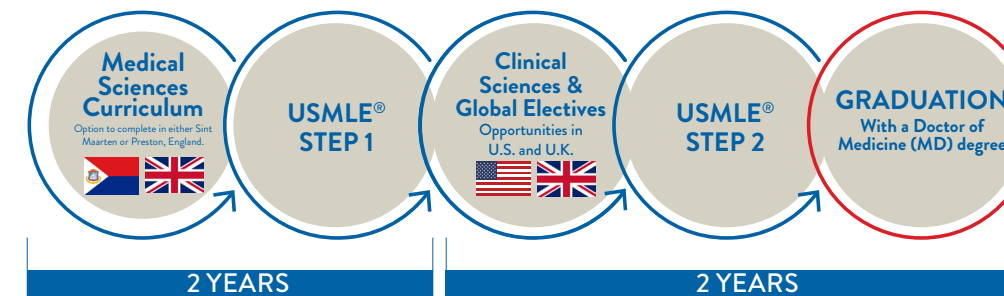

PROGRAM OUTLINE

Our four-year MD program starts with two years of medical sciences curriculum. Students learn how to integrate foundational knowledge with clinical experience.

The final two years are spent completing 80 weeks of clinical rotations, including 42 weeks of core clerkships and 38 weeks of electives.

Students complete core clerkships at AUC School of Medicine's network of affiliated teaching hospitals in the U.S. and U.K. During the 4th year, students can complete elective rotations at various sites in Canada, the U.S. and abroad.



Students enrolled in the U.K. Track will earn a Post Graduate Diploma in International Medical Sciences from UCLan upon successful completion of the Medical Sciences Curriculum

GLOBAL ELECTIVES

Students have the option to complete a six-week clinical rotation in one of six countries: the Dominican Republic, India, Thailand, Uganda, Vietnam, or Zimbabwe. Students gain hands-on training and exposure to different healthcare systems. These valuable experiences are also strong talking points during residency interviews.
