How to apply

1. REVIEW APPLICATION DATES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC) Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate (CSEC) and Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examinations (CAPE)

Minimum requirements:

The completed CAPE diploma must include a total of at least six individual units with grades of one, two or three. Subject to competition, applicants may be required to present averages/grades above the minimum.

CSEC papers must be at the General Proficiency Level, if written before 1998 with grades of one or two, commencing 1998 with grades of one, two or three.

Toronto Met U will also consider a preliminary year at the University of the West Indies, Barbados Community College or equivalent in lieu of the CAPE diploma.

Prerequisite Subject Requirements:

All program specific prerequisite subjects must be included at either the CSEC or CAPE level. Prerequisites at the CAPE Level are highly recommended.

Preference is given to applicants applying to mathematics- and science-based programs that include mathematics, physics, chemistry and biology at the CAPE level (as per applicable program prerequisite subject requirements).

Transfer Credit:

CAPE units with grades of three or better may be considered for transfer credit on an individual basis. Engineering students are not eligible for transfer credits for core and professional engineering courses using CAPE units.

2. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

January admission*

*Only available to applicants who require a Canadian study permit to study at Toronto Metropolitan University.

Apply using the **TMU International Application**. The application deadline is early October. Due to space availability, programs may close applications prior to the deadline.

September admission

Apply using the **TMU International Application** or the **Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) 105 Application**. The application deadline date for guaranteed consideration for the fall term is February 1.

3. UPLOAD REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Once you have received an email acknowledgement of your application, you should begin the process of submitting your transcripts and other supporting documents via the **ChooseTMU Applicant Portal**.

4. CHECK YOUR APPLICATION STATUS

Log in to your **ChooseTMU Applicant Portal** to view letters/documents issued to you by Undergraduate Admissions and to track your application.

International Student Support (ISS)

Budget breakdown

Average costs are based on eight months of full-time study in an undergraduate program for the September and January terms. All amounts are expressed in Canadian dollars.

Tuition and fees

From \$31,749 to \$38,472 for the 2022-2023 academic year, depending on the program of study.

Books and supplies

From \$1,400 to \$9,400, depending on program of study.

Accommodations

On campus:

From \$9,551 to \$13,316, plus meal plan, for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Off campus:

From \$12,000 to \$21,600 for 12 month's rent (or \$1,000 to \$1,800 per month).

Food

From \$4,619 to \$6,262 (five- and seven-day unlimited access meal plan options), depending on living arrangements.

Personal expenses

From \$3,200 to \$5,600 (approximately \$400 to \$700 per month).

Transportation

\$128 within Toronto for a post-secondary TTC monthly pass.

Scholarships and awards

Scholarships for January admission

- International Student Winter Merit Scholarship, valued at up to \$5,000 CAD each.

The application deadline is November 1, 2022.

Scholarships for September admission

- President's Entrance Scholarships, valued at up to \$40,000 CAD each.
- International Secondary School Merit Scholarships, valued at \$5,000 CAD each.

The application deadline is February 1, 2023.

International students (on a study permit) completing studies at a Canadian secondary school may qualify for a Guaranteed and Renewable Scholarship. Refer to our webpage for full details.
