




## BUS PASS

A London Transit Commission bus pass is included within your program's fees for all full-time students in programs with classes on campus (blended format) in London. Simply hop on a bus and tap your FANCard.

Use your FANCard to access after-hours building entrances, computer labs and specialized program-specific facilities. Your card is also used to:
