

# English Language Requirements

An English language proficiency test may be required for international students. If a student has completed a minimum 2 years of study at an institution with English as the language of instruction, an English proficiency test may not be required. Language tests and scores that are acceptable include:

- IELTS 6.5 no band below 6.0
- TOEFL 90 no band below 20
- CAEL 70
- CAE 180
- Completion of StFX English for Academic Purposes program: stfx.ca/eap
- Duolingo 100-115

#### StFX National Entrance Scholarship Program

- \$5,000-\$12,000 (payable over four years)
- Awarded automatically based on your admissions average
- Admissions average of at least 85% required
- You must maintain an average of 80% each y StFX to keep your scholarship

#### StFX Major Scholarships

- \$16,000-\$80,000 (payable over four years)
- Major scholarships require a separate application due March 1, 2024
- You must maintain an average of 80% each year at StFX to keep your scholarship
