We are situated on traditional Anishinaabe and Haudenosaunee Territory along the beautiful waterfront of Lake Ontario. We have a 2nd campus, the Bader International Study Centre (BISC), located on a rural 550-acre estate in East Sussex England. The BISC is a picturesque 15th century castle offering both first year and upper year programming for select faculties.

Our 17 university-and faculty-based research centres provide dynamic, collaborative settings for scholars. Queen's researchers lead the way in many fields, making notable advances recently in particle astrophysics, cancer research, ecological history, and clean energy technology.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Queen's offers a range of scholarships to academically outstanding international students ranging from \$1000 - \$20,000 CAD. Automatic Admission Scholarship ranging from \$1,500-\$4,000 CAD will be offered to all eligible students at the time they receive an offer of admission. Scholarship offers are FIRM – meaning we will honor our original award offer even if your grades decrease. Final grades will be reviewed to assess for further scholarship eligibility in August. ## WORK & STUDY OPTION:

The Queen's Undergraduate Internship Program (QUIP) provides students with a 12-16-month work experience. QUIP internships are paid, professionally supervised, career-related positions designed to offer 2nd or 3rd year students the opportunity to learn about current markets, practices and technologies in business and industry.
