2023 Residency Attainment Highlights

Ross Med graduates can apply for residencies through the National Resident Matching Program[®] and through other sources such as the Canadian Resident Matching Service and Supplemental Offer and Acceptance Program at some of the leading medical institutions in the U.S. In 2023, 597 Ross Med graduates attained residencies in 26 specialties, including dermatology, anesthesiology, emergency medicine, general surgery, interventional radiology, radiation oncology, physical medicine and rehabilitation, and neurology.¹

Our alumni have gone on to achieve positions as chief residents, earn academic posts at U.S. medical schools, become board certified specialists, and be nationally recognized researchers and practitioners.

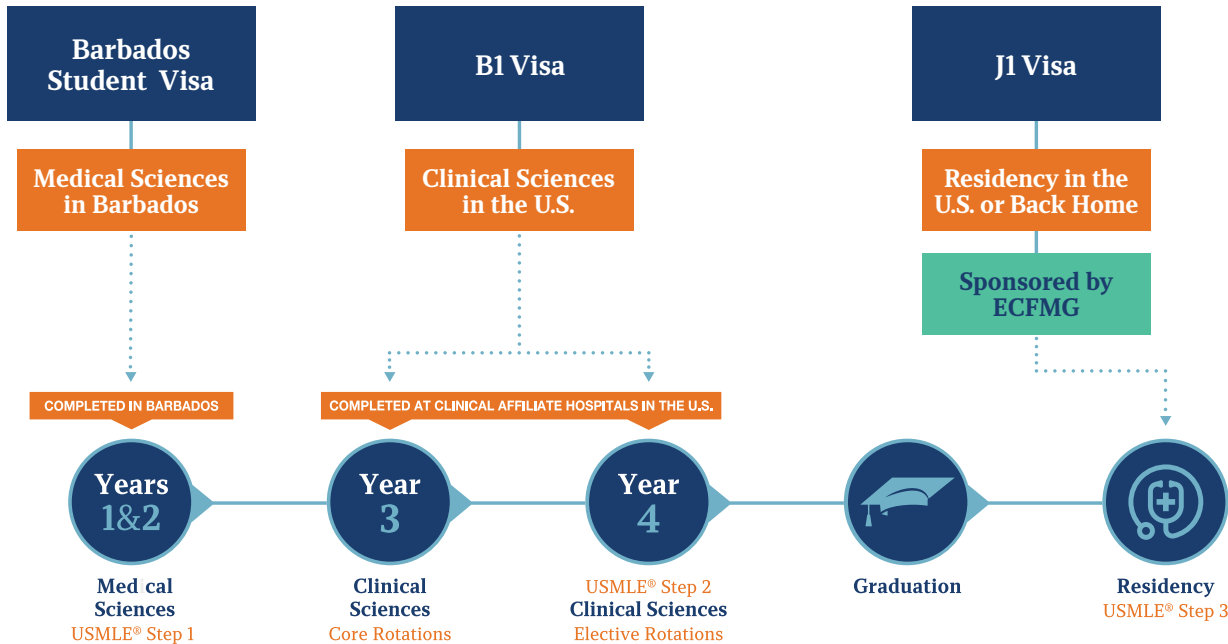

Accreditation

Ross Med is accredited by the Caribbean Accreditation Authority for Education in Medicine and other Health Professions (CAAM-HP, caam-hp.org).⁵ This means you will have the opportunity to become eligible for Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification and to apply for U.S. residencies and licensure.

¹ According to the National Resident Matching Program and institutionally reported data.

² First-time residency attainment rate is the percent of students attaining a 2023–2024 residency position out of all graduates or expected graduates in 2022–2023 who were active applicants in the 2023 NRMP match or who attained a residency position outside the NRMP match.

³ First-time pass rate is the number of students passing the USMLE Step 1 exam on the first attempt divided by the number of students whose first attempt was in 2018–2022. In order to sit for the USMLE Step 1 exam students must successfully complete the Medical Sciences curriculum and earn a satisfactory score on the NBME CBSE exam as listed in the student handbook.

⁴ The MCAT and GPA numbers represent only direct admits to the RUSM program during the 2022–2023 academic year.

⁵ Ross University School of Medicine is an accredited medical school, determined by the Caribbean Accreditation Authority for Education in Medicine and other Health Professions (CAAM-HP, www.caam-hp.org). CAAM-HP is the legally constituted body established in 2003 under the aegis of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), empowered to determine and prescribe standards and to accredit programs of medical, dental, veterinary, and other health professions education on behalf of the contracting parties in CARICOM. Accreditation by CAAM-HP is a rigorous, peer review process which examines all aspects of a medical program. The CAAM-HP board, an independent and autonomous body of professionals, only certifies medical schools which are operating at the highest levels of industry standards. Through this accreditation, the CAAM-HP provides assurance to medical students, graduates, the medical profession, healthcare institutions, and the public that programs leading to qualifications in medicine meet appropriate national and international standards for educational quality, and that the graduates have a sufficiently complete and valid educational experience.
