YOUR PATHWAY TO WILFRID LAURIER UNIVERSITY

WLIC provides a pathway into 60 different programs at Laurier. After completing WLIC, students proceed to the second year of their program at Laurier.

We have flexible start dates (intakes are in January, May and September), lower academic and English requirements for admissions and amazing student support. 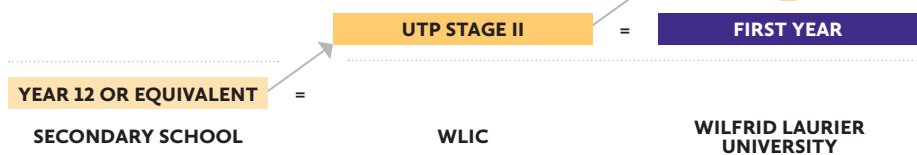
University Transfer Stage 1

For students who have GSCEs or equivalent. Build your foundation before taking UTP2 - your first year equivalence. UTP 1 students who score 70 per cent in each of four courses in term 1, can Jump to UTP2 - meaning they can complete their grade 12 and year one equivalency in just 16 months!



University Transfer Stage 2

For students who have their grade 12/A levels. In UTP2, gain a full year's worth of university experience, develop your study and language skills and move on to year 2 at Laurier. Ideal for students who do not meet language or academic requirements of their program, want flexible start dates and/or want to extra support, smaller classes and a strong chance of success.
